Congratulations and welcome to Fisher College. Our College has a Health Clinic that is available for your use. Along with providing medical services, we also provide assistance in helping to learn how to manage your own health care. Please complete the enclosed health examination forms. ***These forms must be completed in their entirety and returned to the Health Clinic before August 1st, 2011. Please make a copy of all your health forms before you send them to us as back-up in case of loss.***

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts has a law that requires all students to provide documentation of immunizations for tetanus and diphtheria (Td), measles, mumps and rubella (MMR) with 2 MMR shots documented and a series of three (3) hepatitis B shots given over a 6-month period. Meningitis vaccinations are required for all new students arriving on campus, whether or not you live at Fisher.

If you are bringing prescription medications with you, you will need to bring a lock box for maximum security. You also need to check in with me when you arrive.

All Massachusetts College students must have health insurance. A limited coverage policy is available through Fisher College. Many students stay on a 2nd health insurance plan, since our plan does not cover immunizations, annual exams, eye exams or dental expenses.
