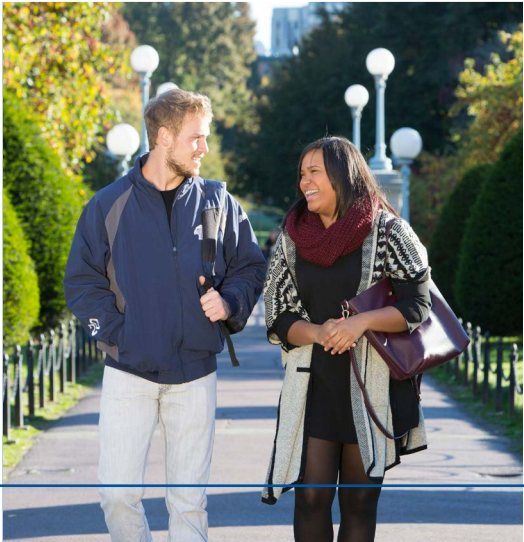

The Fisher College graduate degrees are grounded in the real-world. We currently have an MBA in Strategic Leadership with focuses in Accounting and Sport Administration. In addition, we have a Master of Arts in Psychology and Counseling Psychology with a trauma track that provides graduates with the necessary coursework to sit for the Licensed Mental Health Counselor (LMHC) exam. Programs are offered online, blended and face-to-face.

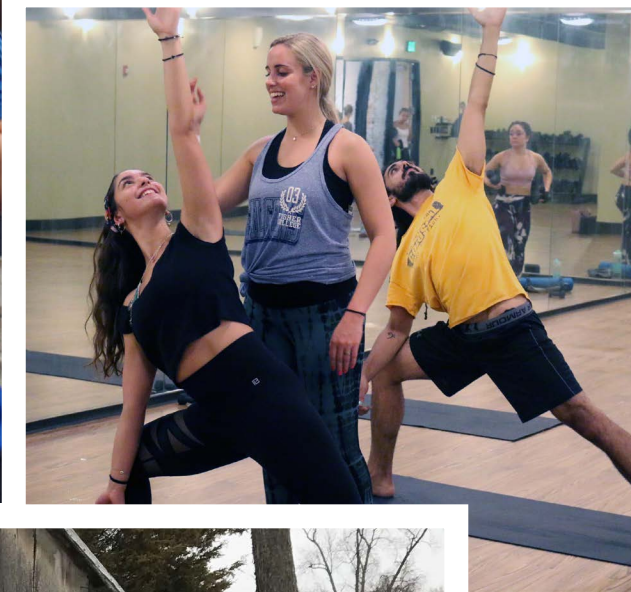

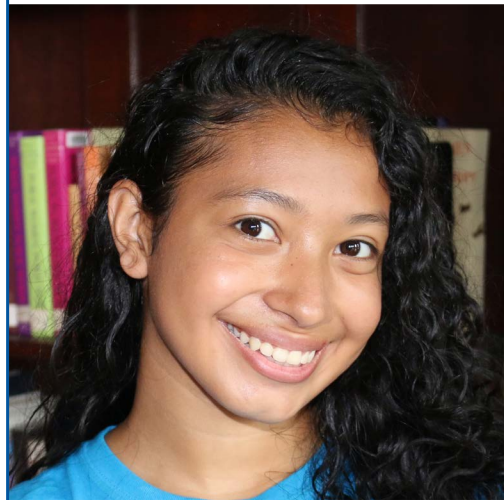
Student Life

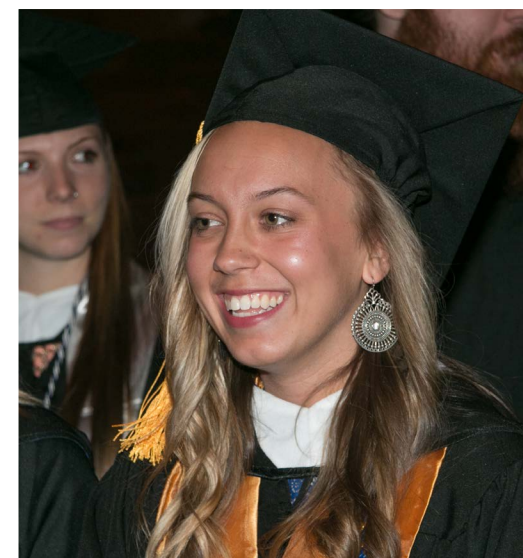
Commuter Life

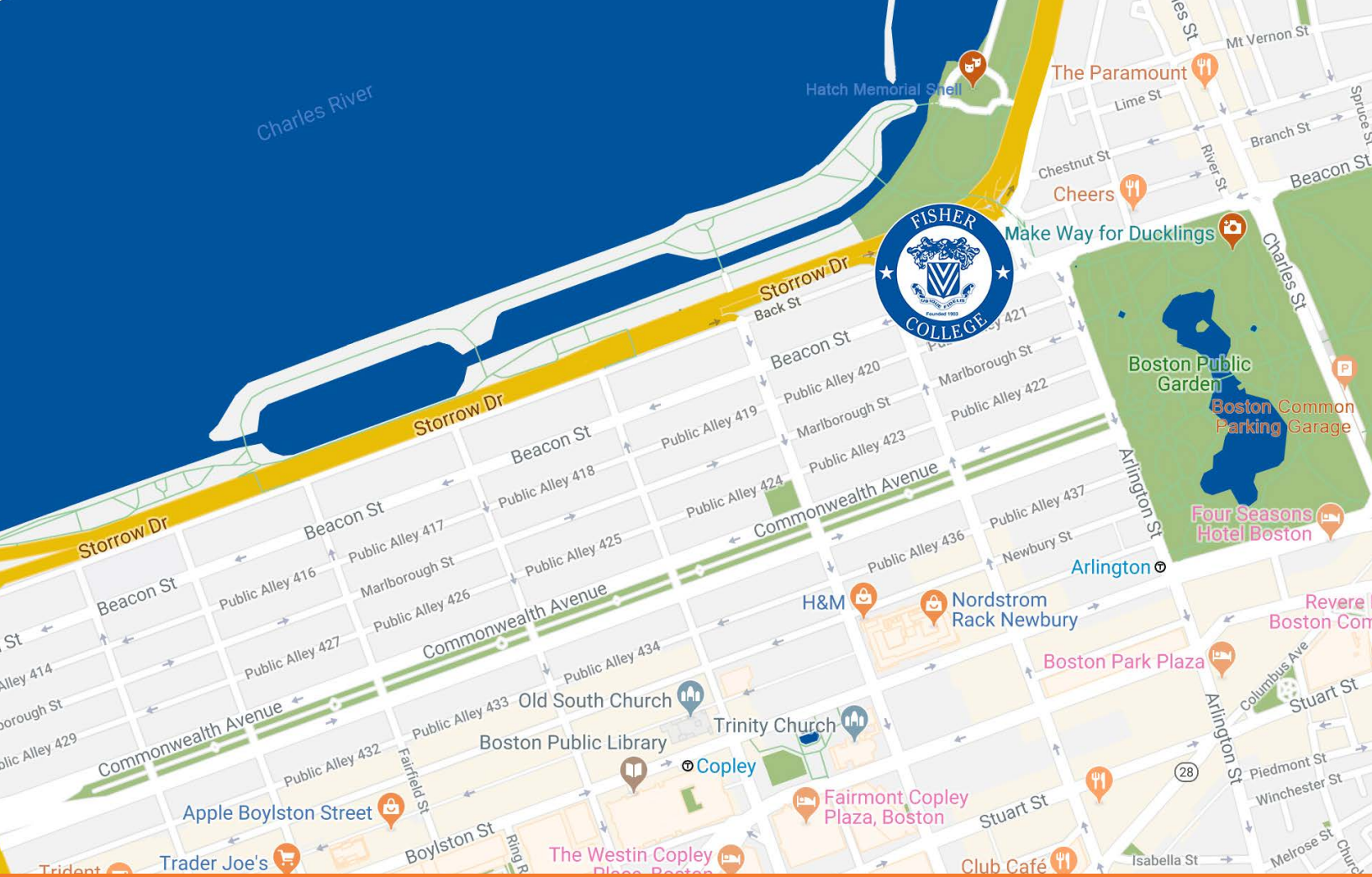
