

The Fisher College Library provides access to numerous databases with thousands of full-text articles that support the curriculum, and they are available to the Fisher College community regardless of location – for free!


<u>Directions for Accessing the Fisher College Library Databases</u>

- 2. Scroll down to the "The Six Pack," and click on the link for "Online Databases."




(Databases are organized by subject)

2. Unless you are using a networked computer on campus, you are considered a remote user. When available, select "Click here for remote access." If a remote link is not available, when you click on the database you want to access, you will be prompted to enter your Fisher College Library barcode. If you are a member of the Fisher College community (student, faculty, or staff) and you do not have your Fisher College Library barcode, please contact us at library@fisher.edu. Note: Your Fisher College Library barcode begins with "256."



3. Library barcodes allow you to access databases as well as place "holds" on materials owned by Fisher College or by any of the member Libraries of the Metro-Boston Library Network. See the "Fisher BiblioCommons Instruction Guide" for more information. Members of the Fisher College community may access any of the databases available remotely through the Boston Public Library (https://www.bpl.org/online-resources/) using a Fisher College Library barcode and a PIN, which has been set as the last four digits of your library barcode.
